



**Oakwood Cemetery Survey Data Legend**

- The **Base Lines** correspond to the center of the Carriage Roads.
- The assigned areas are shown as "A", "B", "C", and "D".
- The deceased person's **Name** is provided if available, otherwise "Unknown" is provided.
- **Monument** number is the area + assigned sequential number, from south to north.
- **Station** number is how many feet and inches from the gate (along the Base Line).
- **Distance** is how many feet and inches (east or west) the monument lies from the base line, to the closest part of the monument. Professional surveying equipment was not used, but distances should be reasonably accurate.
- **Height** is the vertical distance of the monument from the ground to the top in inches to the nearest ¼ inch (the computer spreadsheet is in decimal equivalent).
- **Width** is the horizontal distance in inches to the nearest ¼ inch (spreadsheet in decimal equivalent), generally at the inscription.
- **Condition:** G=Good, F=Fair, W=Weatherworn, L=Legible, L(B)= Barely Legible or only portions are, I=Illegible, D=Damaged surfaces, chipped, or cracked, T=Tilted, S=Sunken.
- **Photo** number is the assigned number (sequentially).
- **Miscellaneous:** Dates if provided, special markings, etc. Effort was made to use exact wording on monuments including punctuations, abbreviations, etc., except semicolons and question marks, and typical use of capital letters is by the writer. Question marks were used when the inscription was weatherworn and not very legible or not known at all.
- **Loose** monuments were found near the maintenance shed and are included on the last page. Perhaps they can be properly relocated.
